STEP 1

Pray

Matthew 6:22 "Your eye is the lamp of the body."

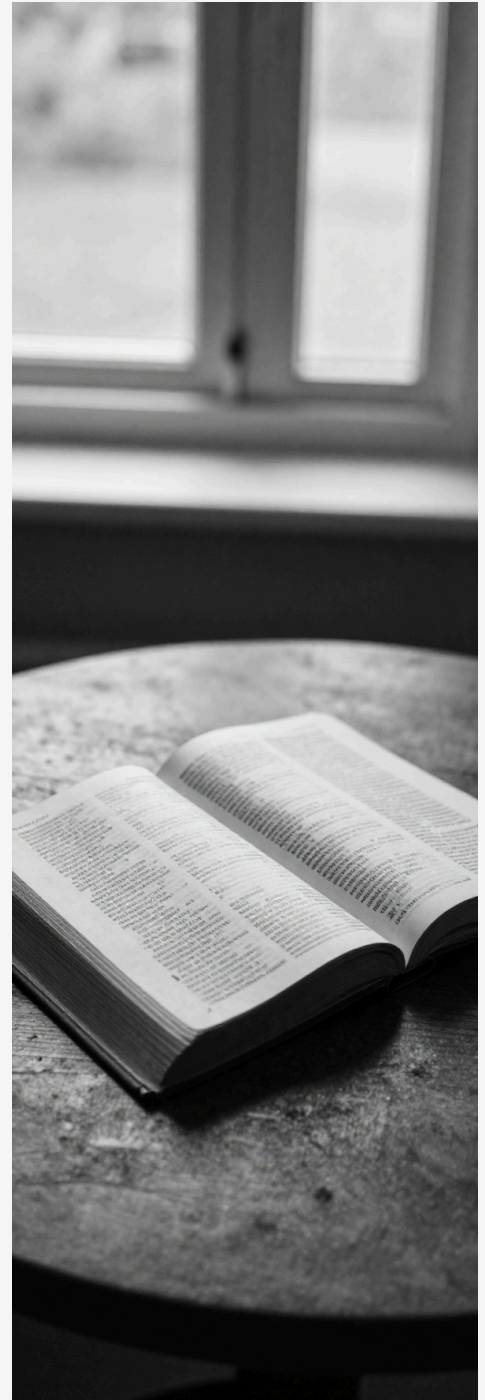
What patterns, habits, or priorities do I notice?
